As The Crow Flies Concrete Disco album release 19th September 2025

As The Crow Flies is the new album from Bristol based electronica trio **Concrete Disco**, led by multi-instrumentalist and chief songwriter Jonny Wharton alongside brothers Joe (keys/laptop) and Dom Cusack (drums/samplers). As The Crow Flies features recent singles Brambles and Rebirth and is due for release on Friday 19th September 2025.

Concrete Disco are a band whose music is based around the phenomenal song-writing and melodies of band leader Jonny Wharton. As The Crow Flies explores journeys in their various forms, opening with Reaching Up which is a pulsing breakbeat paen to optimism, quickly followed up by Brambles which nods to the laconic grooves of acts such as Gorrillaz and features Chinese Malaysian rapper Kai Wei. Jitters addresses the overcoming of self-doubt in a cathartic, piano led tune with epic multi part harmonies, evoking artists such as Spiritualized. Elsewhere tracks such as Bored of Borders, Pay For Your Winnings and Motherland have a harder edge, tackling darker themes of immigration, isolationism and racism, a contrast to the more optimistic, bright-eyed material on the album. A live favourite from the band's recent UK tour opening for The Orb, Running is built around a riff from a Chinese Liuqin, celebrating Jonny's Hong Kong Chinese heritage, set against driving bass, pulsing drums and a propulsive sense of urgency and it calls to mind artists such as Hot Chip. Go Rockets was inspired by Jonny's 4-year-old son's obsession with all things space flight and Gonna End In Tears finds Jonny contemplating mortality and what lies beyond, with Jonny imploring the listener to "make your mark before you disappear". The album closes with the epic two parter Chain Me Up which is based around Jonny's soaring vocal and calls to mind the indie pop vibe of bands such as Yeasayer followed by euphoric electro-house banger Rebirth, a clarion call of self-affirmation with Jonny singing "this is the right time to be here".

Immaculate and innovative production, ear-worm melodies and rousing lyrics combine to produce a record that brings in influences from club icons such as Chemical Brothers along with pop bands such as Hot Chip and even OK Go and Klaxons. With *As The Crow Flies* Jonny and Concrete Disco take the listener on a plunge into the unknown future, a future that will be full of challenges, but ultimately a brighter place to be...

As a formidable live act Concrete Disco have built up a dedicated following in taking their high-octane show to Glastonbury Festival, Secret Garden Party, The Borderline and The Roundhouse, supporting Deadmau5, Modestep, Plump DJs, Beardyman and others along the way. They're playing a monthly residency at The Green Room in Bristol every second Friday of the month, curating a selection of other live electronic artists each time. They've had radio support from cult slots such as Soho Radio, Shoreditch Radio and Eddie Temple-Morris on XFM.
